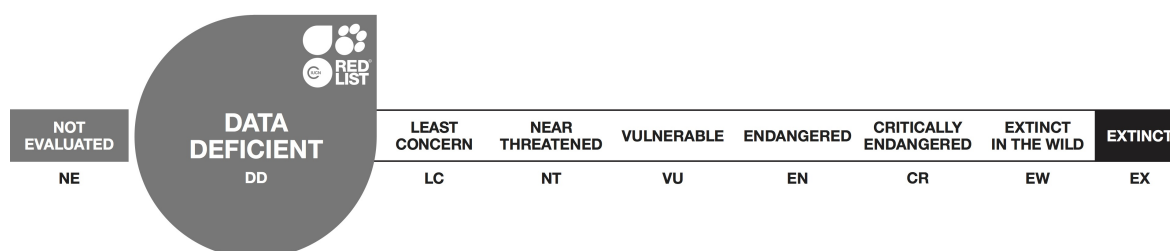

Justification:

Listed as Data Deficient because the species is only known from a few records in the Canary Islands and there is no information on the population size and trend, habitat, ecological requirements and threats. Further research is needed to assess the status of this species.

Geographic Range

Range Description:

This species is only known from Gran Canaria and Tenerife in the Canary Islands.

Country Occurrence:

Native: Spain (Canary Is.)

Population

The population size and trend for this species are unknown. The species is only known from a few records.

Current Population Trend: Unknown

Habitat and Ecology (see Appendix for additional information)

There is no information on the habitat or ecological requirements of this species. This is a kleptoparasitic species, in that it parasitises the nests of other bee species. The host is unknown.

Systems: Terrestrial

Use and Trade

This species is not traded or exploited commercially.

Threats

The threats to this species are unknown.

Conservation Actions (see Appendix for additional information)

This species is not included in any National Red List of Red Data Book. It is not known if the species occur in any protected areas. Further research is needed into the population size and trend, habitat, ecological requirements and threats.
