**Taxon Name:** *Canariella lanosa* (Mousson, 1872)

### Taxonomic Notes:

This species has been treated as a variation of *Canariella hispidula* by Ibanez *et al.* (1995). However, currently this form is considered as a separate species (Bank *et al.* 2002).

### Justification:

This species is endemic to the northern part of the island of Tenerife. Its distribution area is fragmented with an extent of occurrence (EOO) of 250 km<sup>2</sup> and an area of occupancy (AOO) of 20 km<sup>2</sup>. Despite its restricted range, this species is considered Least Concern (LC), because all subpopulations are under protection and face no threats.

### Range Description:

This species is endemic to the northern part of the island of Tenerife. Its distribution area is fragmented with an extent of occurrence (EOO) of 250 km<sup>2</sup> and an area of occupancy (AOO) of 20 km<sup>2</sup>.

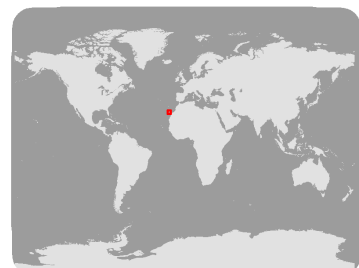
