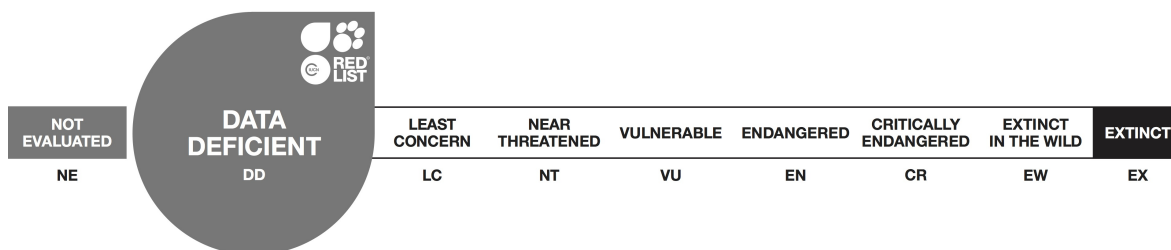

Geographic Range

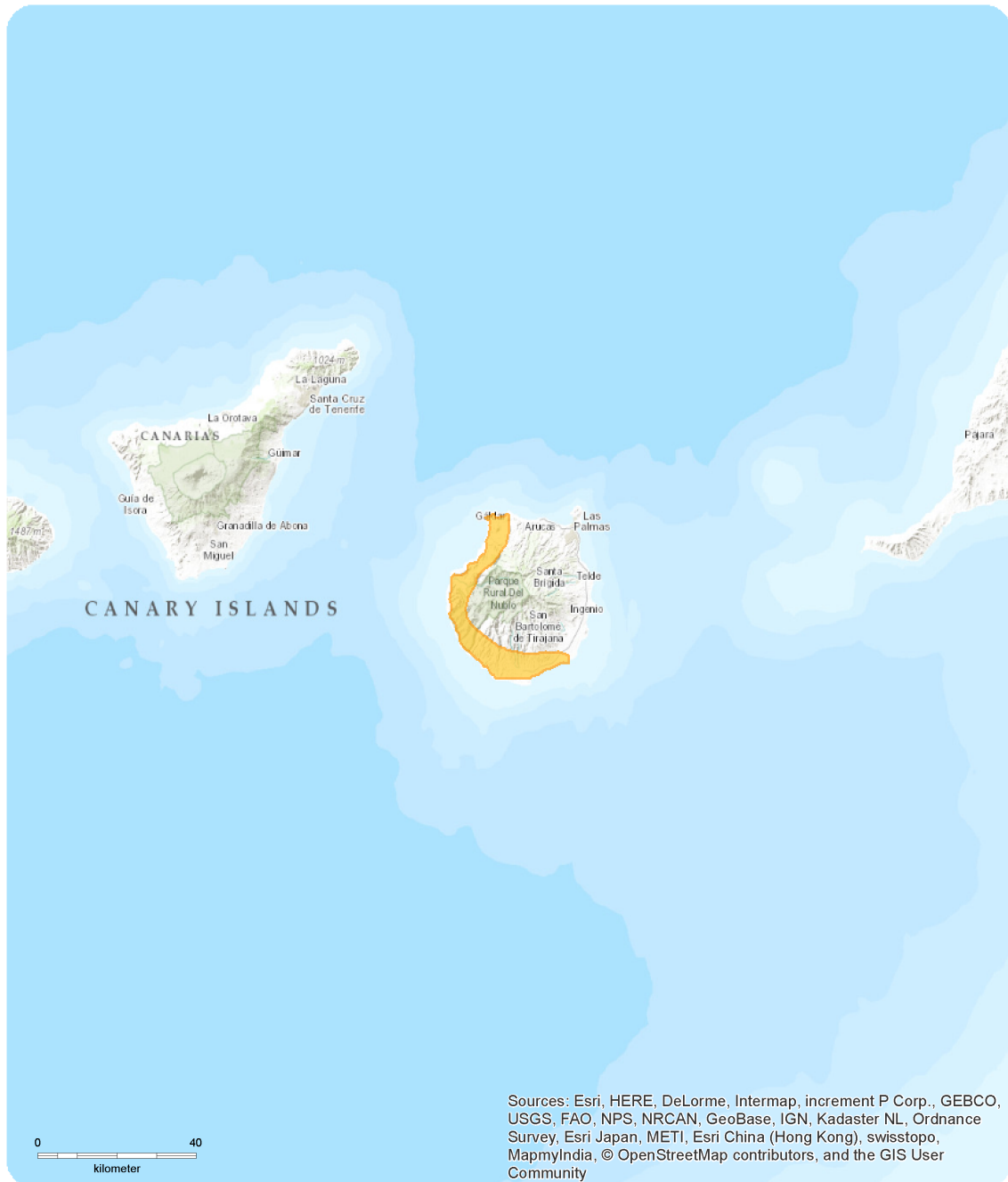
Range Description:

This species is endemic to southern and western Gran Canaria. *Hemicycla psathyra psathyra* is known from the region of Aldea to Mogan, Tarajana, maspalomas and Arguineguin, and *H. psathyra bituminosa* is known from the environments of Galdar. There has been no published data since Wollaston (1878), but at this time it was not rare.

Distribution Map

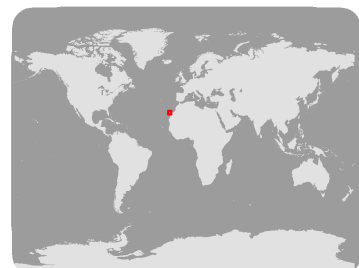
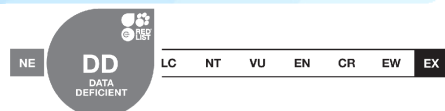


Hemicycla psathyra
