**Taxon Name:** *Monilearia inops* (Mousson, 1872)

### Taxonomic Notes:

This species was never found back since its description. It had been considered a synonym of *Monilearia caementitia* (see Bank *et al.* 2002), but after check of the type specimens it has been raised to a species in its own rights (Fauna Europaea version 2010, <http://www.faunaeur.org>).
