**Taxon Name:** *Napaeus bertheloti* (L. Pfeiffer, 1846)

### Taxonomic Notes:

*Napaeus subsimplex* (Wollaston, 1878) from El Hierro has usually been considered as a synonym of *Napaeus bertheloti*. However, in the latest version of Fauna Europaea, it was listed as a separate species without any published reasoning.

### Justification:

This species is relatively widespread and there is no threat known. It is therefore considered to be Least Concern (LC).

## Geographic Range

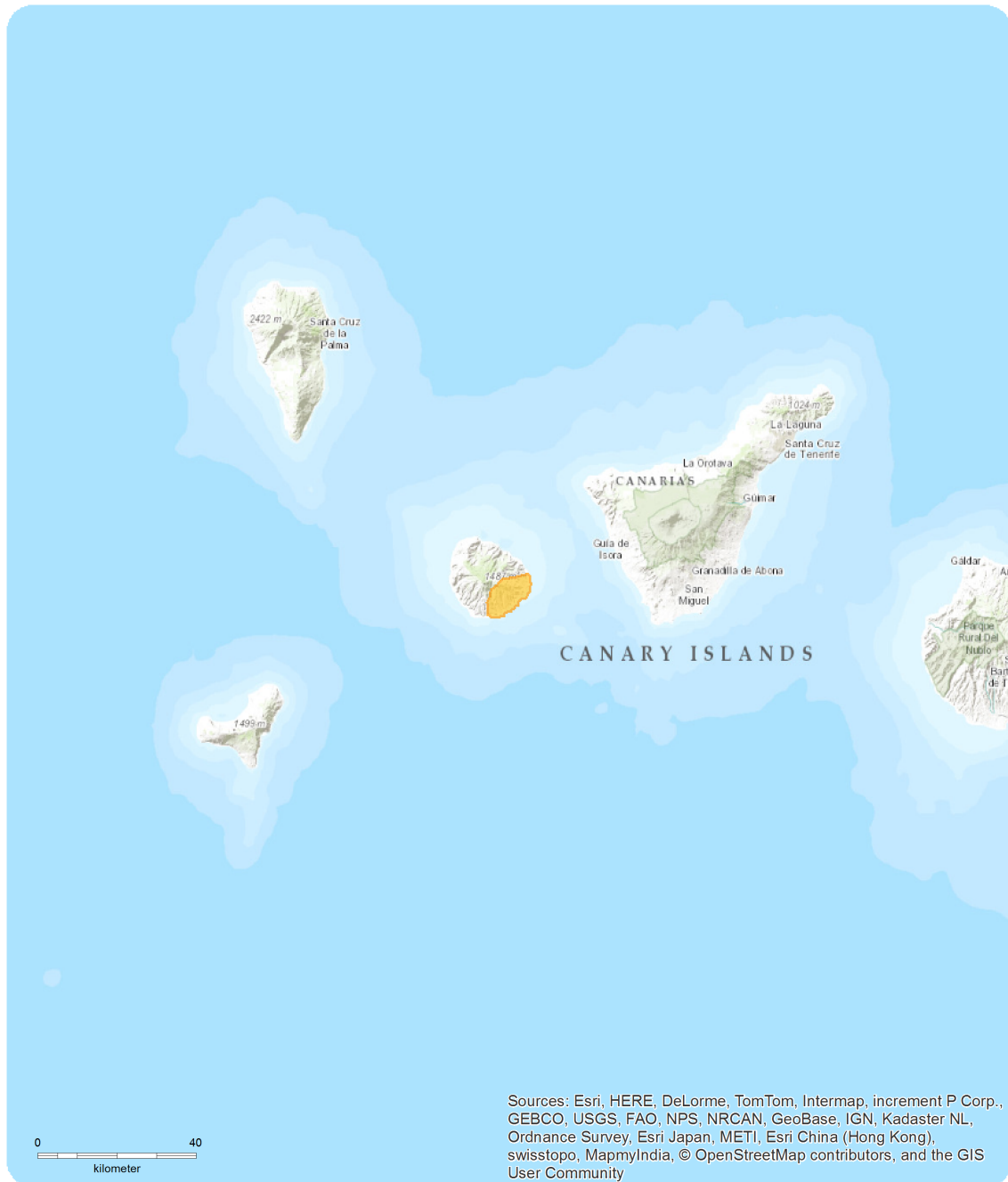
### Range Description:

# Distribution Map

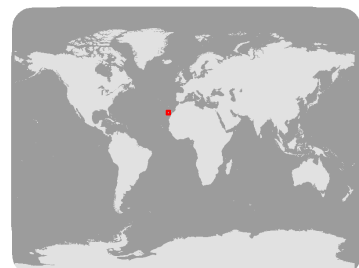


## *Napaeus bertheloti*
