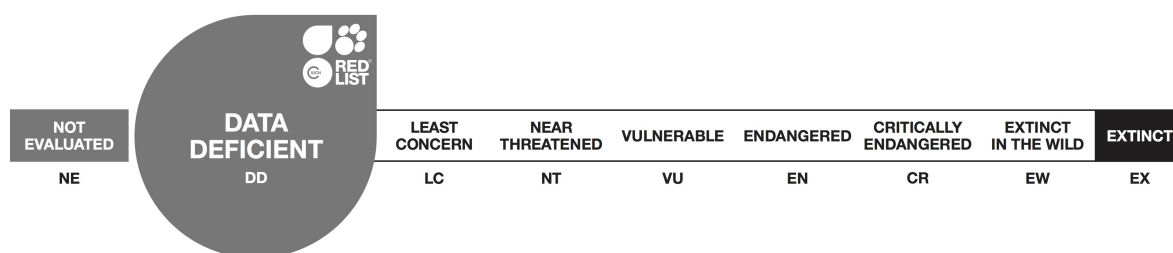

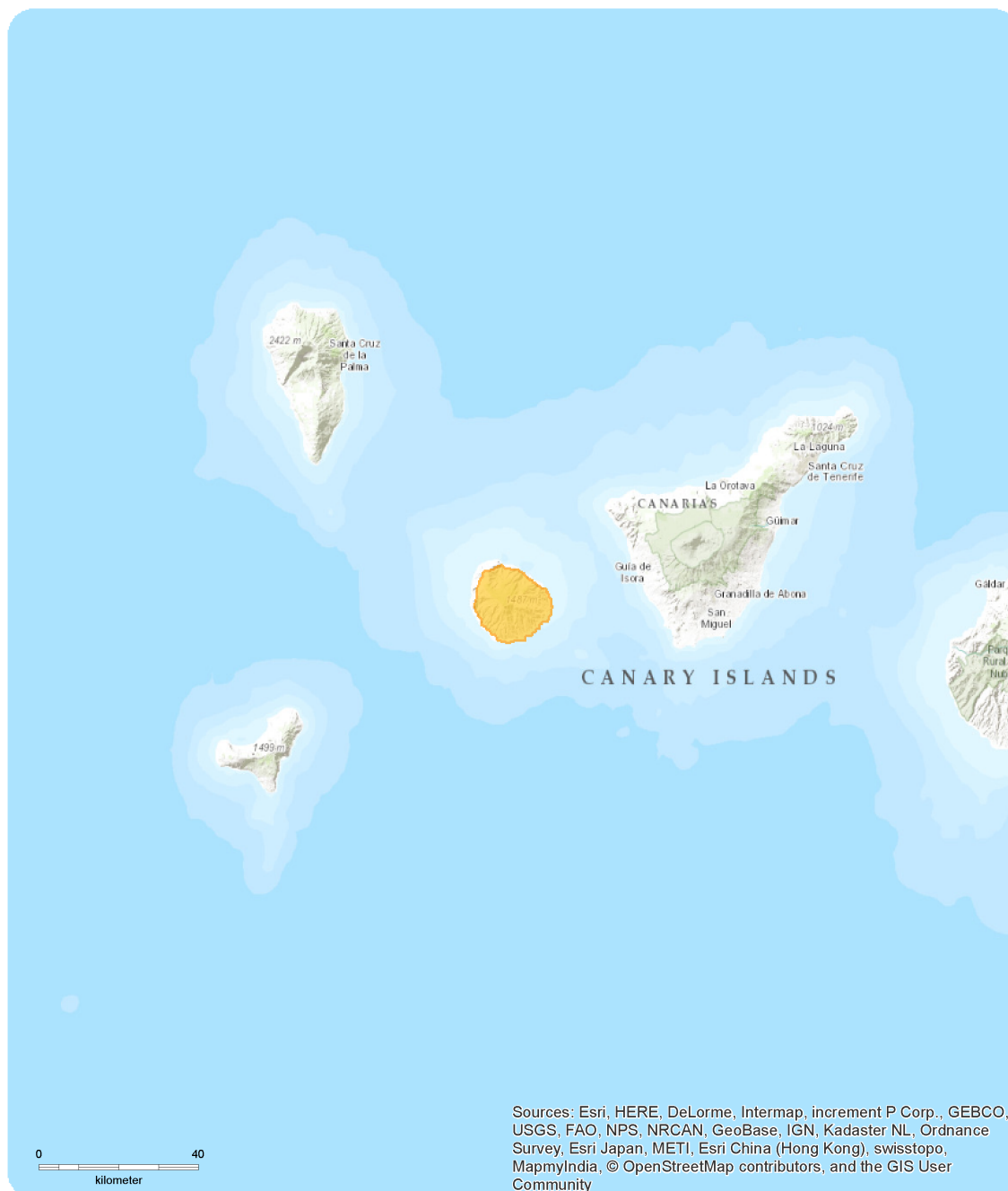
Range Description:

Distribution Map

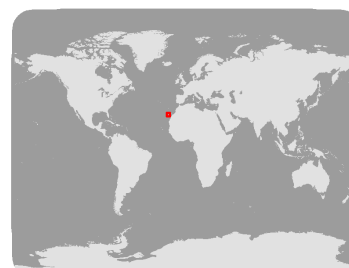


Napaeus texturatus
