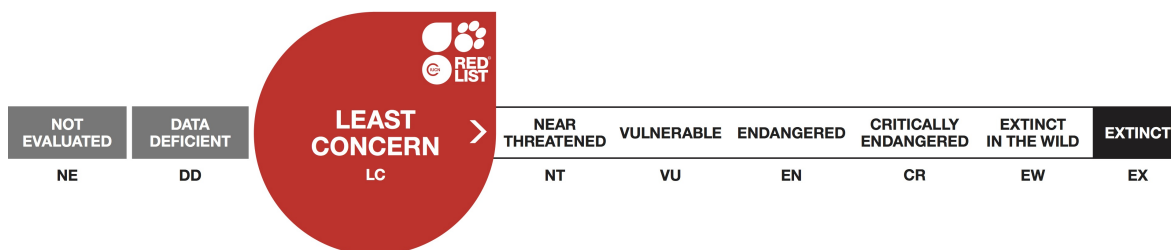

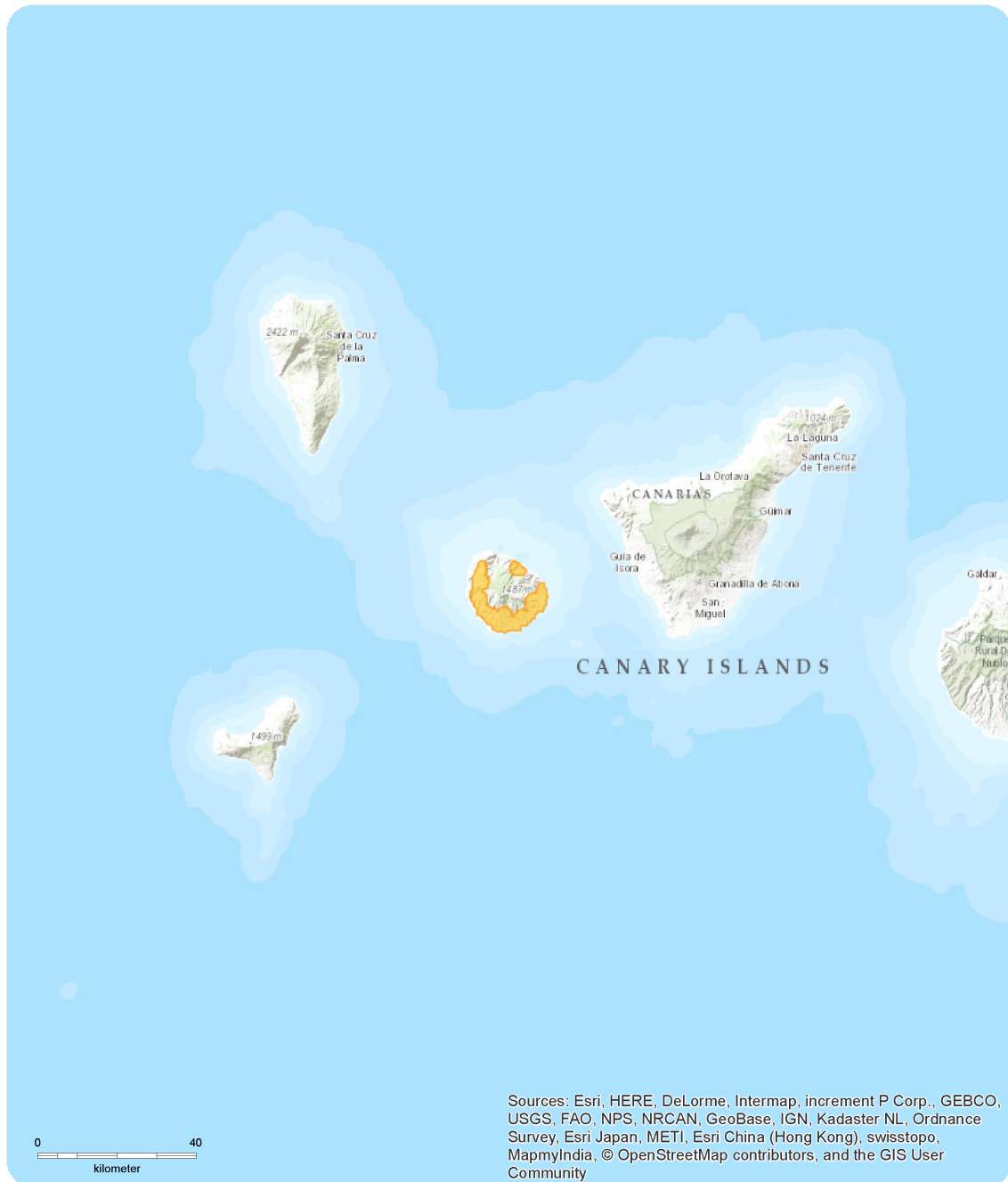
### Range Description:

# Distribution Map

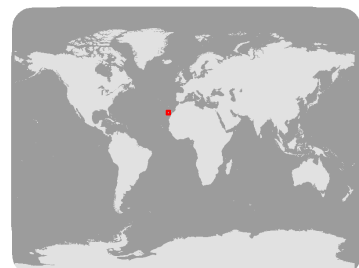
